ROSE

MARC

I came for Thomas.

ROSE

Thomas and I haven't seen you since you left. And now's the time you decide to visit?

MARC

It's not that easy you know it. Let me make it up to you.

ROSE

I don't have time for this.

MARC

I know you're upset. And I am terribly sorry. I had to deal with my own issues first. Don't you get that?

They are interrupted by an old man passing next to them before entering the cemetery.

MARC

Can we please talk somewhere else after this?

ROSE

No we won't. You had plenty of time to talk to me. I would've understood and we would have found an agreement. But you ran away. You left us and found someone else.

ROSE (CONT'D)

Surprised you didn't bring him here. How could Thomas possibly understand what was happening? He was so young. How did you think it was for him growing up?

MARC

Give me a second chance. Let me at least put flowers on his grave.

ROSE

Those flowers? Really? Do you even know your son?

Rose walks away. Marc quickly grabs her.

MARC

Rose wait!

Rose throws his hand away from her.

ROSE

talk to me again.

They both enter.

2. INT. ROSE'S HOUSE - AFTERNOON

The front door opens. Rose enters. Sobbing. Her phone buzzes in her pocket. She ignores it. She lays her back against the door for a moment and stares in the distance.

There stands THOMAS (23), a greyscale ghost, looking confused to be here. He tries to call for her but no sound comes out of his mouth. Thomas is shocked and puts his hand on his throat. He tries to talk but again no sound comes out.

Rose gets away from the door and walks to the couch. Thomas tries to hug her but an invisible force pushes him slightly to the side as his mother passes by him. He seems even more confused.

Rose lays on the couch with her son's portrait. Thomas kneels next to her. He tries to comfort her but his hand stops a few centimeters before he could reach her. Something prevents him from touching her. He's incapable of interacting with the living. Realizing this he stumbles backwards and accidentally hits the mug sitting on the edge of the coffee table. He sees his mother getting ready to swallow the few pills she picked up in one hand while holding the glass in the other hand. To distract and scare her, Thomas starts to make a big mess in her room. She tries to bring the fork to her mouth but her emotions takes over. She starts sobbing, dropping the fork. She sniffs and forces herself not to cry even more.

5. INT. KITCHEN - CONTINUOUS

Rose throws away the pasta. As she washes the dishes she stares through the window. After one plate done she places it on a dish tray and notices a sharp knife sitting there. Her hand shakes as she slowly hover it above the knife. Thomas in the background notices it and frantically looks around him trying to find something to stop her.

Rose enters the store ringing the bell. She notices the orchids. She continues to look at it while walking towards the counter. Thomas is following behind looking around the shop.

SAM

Good morning Mrs. Vernier. How are you today?

ROSE

As good as it could be. How's today's flowers.

SAM

Well... I... I wanted to call earlier but I do not have your new phone number. I unfortunately do not have roses for you today. We had such high demands. I couldn't...

ROSE

I'm sorry. You don't have roses anymore? The only flowers I ask for every week for my son's grave and you don't have.

SAM

I know and I am truly sorry. I could offer other flowers...

ROSE

The only flowers I order are roses. They were my mother's flowers and they were my son's too. I don't want other flowers.

Rose turns around and leaves the store shutting the door. The vase of orchids falls down on the ground and shatters. Sam rushes to save them.

Thomas disoriented by her fury forgets to follow her. Stunned by the scene. He notices a pen and a notebook on the counter. He writes down his mother's phone number and address.

7. EXT. ROSE'S HOUSE - MORNING

Rose opens the door and is about to step outside when she notices a bouquet of roses at her doorstep. A little envelope sits on top of it. She opens the letter and finds all the cash she gave to Sam. Her phone buzzes. It's a text from him. It says: Let me know if you got the bouquet. Again, I am very sorry.

8. INT. SAM'S SHOP - DAY

The door bell rings as Rose enters the shop. The store is filled with flowers but Sam is nowhere to be seen.

ROSE

Is anyone there? Sam?

Sam suddenly pops his head from behind a big vase of orchids. He is hiding something behind his back.

SAM

Mrs. Vernier. I didn't expect to see you back.

ROSE

Listen Sam, I want to apologize for what I did last week about...

SAM

Oh it's ok. Don't worry I understand.

Sam walks to her. He has one hand on her shoulder. The other hand still holding something in his back.

SAM

I got you something.

Sam brings out from his back a magnificent bouquet of crimson red roses with one yellow orchid.

ROSE

Sam... What...

SAM

It's a gift. From the house. The best roses I could find and a yellow orchid to represent the warmth of love. Just a little touch. Do you think Thomas would like it?

ROSE

SAM

ROSE

SAM

I wanted to give you this.

It's a bouquet of colorful orchids. He hands it over and takes a step back. She takes it and smiles at the beautiful scent. Thomas is in awe.

SAM

I thought you'd like some flowers for yourself. And you seemed to like my orchids so...

Rose hides herself from blushing behind the bouquet.

SAM

May I come in?

She hesitates. Takes a quick glance inside her messy house then back at the bouquet.

ROSE

Uh yes please come in. Let me make you some tea.
